

### **City of Springfield (Clark County) Cities**

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BWC approved \$33,791 to purchase nine stair chairs with accessories and two power cots with accessories to reduce the risk of injury related to repetitive motion, and manually lifting and loading/unloading patients into and out of emergency vehicles. This intervention will improve the process of patient handling and lifting. The Springfield Fire Department provides fire suppression, fire prevention, emergency medical services and public education to the residents of Clark County.

### **General Data Co. (Clermont County) Manufacturing**

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BWC approved \$1,840 to purchase a pallet positioner to reduce the risk of injury to hands, fingers, wrists, back and legs related to hand force, awkward postures, contact stress, push pull heavy/moderate load, and manual material handling load/frequency. This intervention will improve the boxing and stacking processes. General Data manufactures narrow Web labels. It labels in roll, fanfold and in stacks of sheets.

### **General Data Co. (Clermont County) Manufacturing**

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BWC approved \$5,482 to purchase a conveyor to reduce the risk of injury to the wrists, neck, shoulders, hands, legs and back related to awkward posture, bending, repetitive motion, contact stress, push/pull, hand force and manual material handling, heavy load and frequency. This intervention will improve the production, packaging and palletizing processes. General Data manufactures narrow Web labels. It procures labels in roll, fanfold and in stacks of sheets.

### **Mikouis Enterprises Inc. dba Sunrise Homes (Columbiana County) Service**

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BWC approved \$ 8,010 to purchase a portable lift hands control to reduce the risk of injury to the arms, shoulders, back and legs related to awkward postures and manual materials handling load/frequency. This intervention will improve the patient lifting and transporting process. Sunrise Homes, a long-term care facility, provides round-the-clock care to individuals with severe physical and cognitive disabilities.

### **Annin & Company (Coshocton County) Manufacturing**

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BWC approved \$3,983 to purchase two power-lift trucks and 36 spring lift platforms to reduce the risk of injury to the hands, wrists, shoulders, arms, fingers and lower extremities related to awkward postures, contact stress, push/pull heavy load, repetition and manual materials handling heavy load. This intervention will improve the manual lifting, loading and unloading process. Annin Flagmakers manufactures flags and ships them to U.S. retail and hardware chains.

### **Bradley Stone Industries Ltd. (Cuyahoga County) Manufacturing**

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BWC approved \$40,000 to re-install existing ceiling mounted crane, extend existing crane system 50', add two additional bridges and hoists, including festoon cables and carriers, purchase two one-ton hoists and 10 rolling carts. Bradley Stone Industries will makes these purchases to reduce the risk of injury to shoulders, hands, back and lower extremities due to contusions, cuts, hands intensive work, lifting, pushing, pulling, repetitive motion and awkward postures. This intervention will reduce the manual handling and maneuvering of materials during production. Bradley Stone Industries makes and installs custom granite countertops and other specialty pieces.

### **C & K Industrial Services Inc. (Cuyahoga County) High Risk Commercial/Service**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase one water jetting tool to reduce the risk of injury to back, hands, eyes and lower extremities due to chemical exposure, contusions, cuts, hand intensive work, lifting, pushing, pulling and repetitive motions. This intervention will mechanically perform hydro blasting operations through an automated robotic system. This will reduce the amount of physical labor needed during operation. C&K Industrial Services provides services, including hydro blasting, industrial vacuuming, sewer cleaning, hydro evacuation and other services for the metal, power generation, chemical, oil refining, food processing, paper and municipal industries.

### **Cleveland Thermal LLC. (Cuyahoga County) Utility**

BWC approved \$17,325 to purchase two scissor lifts to reduce the risk of injury to the wrists, neck, shoulders, hands, legs and back related to climbing, manual material handling and fall from heights. This intervention will reduce the use of ladders while providing maintenance and repairs. Cleveland Thermal is an energy manufacturer and supplier. It provides thermal heating and cooling service to commercial and residential properties.

### **Gent Machine Co. (Cuyahoga County) Manufacturing**

BWC approved \$29,306 to purchase five noise reducing machine enclosures to reduce the risk of injury to ears and potential hearing loss due to high noise levels. This intervention will reduce the noise levels to acceptable, safe levels for the machine operators. Gent Machine machines and manufactures smaller scale industrial fittings for multiple industries.

### **Volpe Millwork Inc. (Cuyahoga County) Manufacturing**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase one CNC router package to reduce the risk of injury to back, neck, shoulders, arms, hands and lower extremities due to bending, pushing, pulling, awkward postures and repetitive motions. This intervention will process materials that reduce the employee's handling of heavy materials during processing. Volpe Millwork provides residential and commercial clients with design, fabrication and construction services specializing in custom cabinetry and casework.

### **MJM Industries Inc. (Cuyahoga County) Manufacturing**

BWC approved \$28,799 to purchase one laser striping system, one air cleaning system and one laser power meter to reduce the risk of injury to hands due to cuts, hands intensive work, pushing, pulling and repetitive motion. This intervention will reduce the need to manually strip wires and carry away emissions from the laser system through the implementation of an air cleaning system. MJM Industries manufactures custom electrical and electronic assemblies ranging from wire harnesses, cable assemblies, over-molded products and flat flex cable assemblies.

### **Hohler Furnace & Sheet Metal Inc. (Erie County) Construction**

BWC approved \$14,642 to purchase a scissor lift and a material lift to reduce the risk of injury to the hands, wrists, shoulders, arms, fingers and lower extremities related to awkward postures, contact stress, push/pull heavy load, repetition, manual materials handling heavy load and fall from heights. This intervention will improve the duct installation process. Hohler Furnace & Sheet Metal is a full service heating, cooling and sheet metal fabrication company. It serves residential and commercial customers in Northern Ohio.

### **Simmons & Kleinline Inc. (Fairfield County) Construction**

BWC approved \$14,623 to purchase one lift to reduce the risk of injury to the wrists, neck, shoulders, hands, legs and back related to climbing, manual material handling and fall from heights. This intervention will reduce the use of ladders while providing maintenance and repairs. Simmons & Kleinline is a contractor for commercial projects, mainly doing drywall work and ceiling installation.

### **Arbor Inc. (Franklin County) Agriculture**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase a track mounted lift to reduce the risk of injury to the wrists, neck, shoulders, hands, legs and back related to climbing, manual material handling and fall from heights. This intervention will reduce the use of ladders and ropes needed for climbing during the tree removal process. Arbor is a full service arboricultural firm serving residential and commercial clients.

### **C.O.W. Industries Inc. (Franklin County) Manufacturing**

BWC approved \$17,287 to purchase one scrap conveyor and five lift tables to reduce the risk of injury to back, neck and shoulders due to lifting, pushing, pulling and repetitive motion. This intervention will allow employees to work on parts and materials at a more ergonomically correct height and reduce the amount of pushing, pulling and lifting needed to empty scrap bins. C.O.W. is a custom sheet metal fabrication company.

### **Columbus Asphalt Paving Inc. (Franklin County) Construction**

BWC approved \$37,396 to purchase one set of four mobile vehicle lifts and two hydraulic floor jacks to reduce the risk of injury to back due to bending, twisting, pushing, pulling and awkward positions. The intervention will reduce the need to manually lift heavy vehicles off the ground and reduce the amount of pushing, pulling and awkward positions that occur while providing maintenance to vehicles. Columbus Asphalt Paving is a general contractor that performs various types of asphalt and concrete roadway work.

### **Danite Holdings Ltd. (Franklin County) Construction**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase an auger compressor and accessories to reduce the risk of injury to hands, neck, shoulders, wrists, fingers, back and legs related to contact stress, awkward postures, repetition, and push/pull heavy equipment. This intervention will improve the crate break down process. Danite Holdings designs, manufactures/fabricates and installs both small and large signage.

### **Engineered Profiles Inc. (Franklin County) Manufacturing**

BWC approved \$26,817 to purchase 13 silo level monitoring "yo-yo's" to reduce the risk of injury or possible fatality due to exposure to extreme weather, slips, trips and falls from heights. This intervention will monitor silo levels from ground as opposed to climbing on top of the silo. Engineered Profiles manufactures custom plastic extrusions for a diverse range of industries specializing in PVC, wood composite, foam PVC, ABS, PP and other specialty thermoplastic raw materials.

### **G D Paine Inc. (Franklin County) Transportation**

BWC approved \$3,772 to purchase one stair climber to reduce the risk of injury to back, neck, shoulders, fingers and lower extremities due to lifting, bending, pushing, pulling and repetitive motion. This intervention will reduce the need to manually push/pull/carry equipment increasing productivity, efficiency, and safety. G D Paine offers a range of logistics services, primarily transporting and delivery to areas that include airfreight, warehouses, home delivery and dedicated shuttle operations.

### **PMPG Enterprises LLC. dba Archbold Furniture (Fulton County) Manufacturing**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase one fan, one vacuum, one thermal imaging camera, four dust extractors and one sanding booth to reduce the risk of injury due to slips, trips, falls, possible explosion and inhalation of dust particles due to accumulation of dust on floors and surfaces, and air borne particulates. This intervention will mitigate the risks of fire, explosion and inhalation caused by wood dust. Archbold Furniture manufactures solid wood unfinished furniture.

### **Bushelman Supply Co. (Hamilton County) Construction**

BWC approved \$24,195 to purchase one walk behind skid steer with one bucket, one adjustable fork, one stump grinder and one tree fork attachment to reduce the risk of injury to shoulders, back and knees due to lifting, carrying, bending, twisting and repetitive motion. This intervention will reduce the amount of manual labor associated with landscaping; thereby, reducing injuries and increasing productivity and efficiency. Bushelman Supply is involved in retail and wholesale sales and loading, delivery and installation of hardscape materials such as sand, gravel, topsoil, mulch and various stone products.

### **Ford Development Corp. (Hamilton County) Construction**

BWC approved \$13,520 to purchase a concrete buggy to reduce the risk of injury to the hands, wrists, fingers, shoulders, back and legs related to awkward postures, contract stress, hand force, push/pull moderate/heavy loads, manual materials handling load/frequency and environment. The intervention will improve the specialty concrete processes. Ford Development is a general contractor that specializes in roadway improvements, sidewalks, machine bases, specialty concrete, utility work, sewer and water lines.

### **Forest Park (Hamilton County) Cities**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase two power cots and two power load systems to reduce the risk of injury related to repetitive motion, and manually lifting and loading/unloading patients into and out of emergency vehicles. This intervention will improve the process of patient handling and lifting. The Forest Park Fire Department provides fire protection and emergency medical services for its residents.

### **Servatii Inc. (Hamilton County) Manufacturing**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase one dough chunker and elevator to reduce the risk of injury to back, shoulders and knees due to lifting, pushing, pulling, repetitive motion, slips, trips and falls. This intervention will reduce the amount of manual material handling and overhead lifting needed during production. Servatii is a full line bakery and deli.

### **Monclova Township (Lucas County) Townships**

BWC approved \$39,077 to purchase two powered cots and a powered load system to reduce the risk of injury related to manually lifting and loading/unloading patients into and out of emergency vehicles. This intervention will improve the process of patient handling and lifting by reducing repetitive lifting. Monclova Township is an unincorporated township located in Northwest Ohio, just outside of Toledo. Monclova Township Fire & Rescue Department offers emergency medical services for its residents.

### **Morgan Services Inc. (Lucas County) Service**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase three evaporative cooling units to reduce the risk of injury or illness due to extreme heat. This intervention intervention is to spot cool areas where the heat is most intense and provide direct airflow to all workers in the facility. Morgan Services is a commercial laundry and linen provider.

### **Brentwood Originals Inc. (Mahoning County) Manufacturing**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase one case erector/sealer to reduce the risk of injury to shoulders, back and hands due to contusions, cuts, hands intensive work and repetitive motion. This intervention will reduce the use of manual tape guns and the need to erect shipping cases manually.

Brentwood Originals manufactures, packs, and ships decorative pillows and outdoor cushions to retailers.

### **Marshall Dayton Tire Sales Co. (Montgomery County) Commercial**

BWC approved \$988 to purchase a shop press to reduce the risk of injury to the hands, elbow, arms, neck, back and legs related to heavy lifting, push/pull heavy loads, awkward posture, bending and repetition. This intervention will improve the automotive parts press process. Marshall Dayton Tire Sales is a full service auto repair and maintenance facility located in Dayton, Ohio. Marshall Dayton Tire Sales specializes in all aspects of auto maintenance, including but not limited to, Brakes, shocks and struts, A/C maintenance and repair, tune-ups and wheel alignments.

### **Pickaway Plains Ambulance Services Inc. (Pickaway County) Transportation**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase four powered cots to reduce the risk of injury related to manually lifting and loading/unloading patients into and out of emergency vehicles. This intervention will improve the process of patient handling and lifting by reducing repetitive lifting. Pro Care Medical Transportation Services offers advanced life support, intermediate support, basic life support and ambulance services to its clients.

### **Village of Lewisburg (Preble County) Villages**

BWC approved \$8,989 to purchase one power-stretcher system to reduce the risk of injury related to repetitive motion, and manually lifting and loading/unloading patients into and out of emergency vehicles. This intervention will improve the process of patient handling and lifting. The Lewisburg Fire/EMS Department provides fire protection and emergency medical services for its residents of .

### **Lamb Builders LLC. (Richland County) Construction**

BWC approved \$34,975 to purchase a tiller and a mini track loader to reduce the risk of injury to the hands, wrists, shoulders, arms, fingers, back and legs related to awkward postures, contact stress, push/pull heavy load, repetition and manual materials handling heavy load. This intervention will improve the digging and trenching processes. Lamb Builders is a residential home builder and general contractor.

### **Scioto County Government (Scioto County) Counties**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase one roof rigger, one mid roof descender, one harness vest, one bosons chair, 150-foot chair rope, one rope guard, one scissor lift, two load platforms, one towable man lift, 150-foot safety rope and one rope grab. Scioto County will use this equipment to reduce the risk of injury to the wrists, neck, shoulders, hands, legs and back or possible fatality related to climbing, manual material handling and fall from heights. This intervention will reduce the use of ladders while providing maintenance and repairs, provide anchorage points that are stable and secure. This will allow employees to safely access and repair exterior high areas, and reduce the manual lifting and carrying of boxes. Scioto County maintenance department performs various material handling and maintenance tasks throughout the County Courthouse and at other county owned properties.

### **Quick Tab II Inc. (Seneca County) Manufacturing**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase a stationary pile turner and air jogger to reduce the risk of injury to back, shoulders, hands and knees due to hands intensive work, lifting and repetitive motion. This intervention will reduce the manual handling of materials during production. QuickTab II is a printing company that specializes in secure document printing, including payroll checks and commercial printing.

### **City of Twinsburg (Summit County) Cities**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase two power cots, three power load systems, and three mass casualty mats to reduce the risk of injury related to repetitive motion, and manually lifting and loading/unloading patients into and out of emergency vehicles. This intervention will improve the process of patient handling and lifting. The Twinsburg Fire Department provides fire, emergency medical services, hazmat and technical services to Twinsburg and Twinsburg Township.

### **Copley Township (Summit County) Townships**

BWC approved \$21,143 to purchase a powered load system to reduce the risk of injury related to manually lifting and loading/unloading patients into and out of emergency vehicles. This intervention will improve the process of patient handling and lifting by reducing repetitive lifting. The Copley Township Fire Department provide emergency medical services for its residents. The township includes large areas of wetlands, small farms, large housing developments, a small industrial section, and a large commercial and retail center.

### **Copley Township (Summit County) Townships**

BWC approved \$6,146 to purchase a hose reel to reduce the risk of injury to the wrists, neck, shoulders, hands, legs and back related to repetitive motion, hand force, awkward posture, twisting, bending and push/pull heavy load. This intervention will improve the manual hose draining and storage process. The Copley Township Fire Department provide emergency medical services for its residents. The township includes large areas of wetlands, small farms, large housing developments, a small industrial section and a large commercial and retail center.

### **Gary Riggs DVM dba Barberton Veterinary Clinic (Summit County) Service**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase a digital imaging system to reduce the risk of injury to the hands, neck, shoulders and wrists related to repetition, hand force, awkward postures, contact stress, push/pull heavy/moderate load and manual materials handling load/frequency. This intervention will improve the radiology process. The Barberton Veterinary Clinic is an American Animal Hospital Association accredited veterinary hospital. Barberton Veterinary Clinic provides medical and surgical care to dogs, cats, wildlife and all types and sizes of exotic animals.

### **Castings USA Inc. (Tuscarawas County) Manufacturing**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase a vibratory shakeout and sand processing unit to reduce the risk of injury to back, neck, shoulders, arms, eyes and lower extremities due to contusions, cuts, hand intensive work, lifting, pushing, pulling, repetitive motion and flying debris. This intervention will provide a means to mechanically shake out castings, separate molds and breakdown lumps of sand. Castings USA is primarily engaged in pouring molten pig iron or iron alloys into molds to manufacture castings such as clay extrusion equipment, bearing guides and street lamp bases.

### **Marietta College (Washington County) Service**

BWC approved \$37,197 to purchase one waste caddy, eight dumpster receivers, one battery upgrade, one internal charger upgrade and one towable boom lift to reduce the risk of injury to the wrists, neck, shoulders, hands, legs and back related to climbing, pushing, pulling and fall from heights. This intervention will reduce the use of ladders while providing maintenance and repairs, and reduce the amount of manual pushing and pulling of dumpsters. Marietta College is a private, coeducational, liberal arts college.

### **Waterford Township (Washington County) Townships**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase two power cots and one-power load systems to reduce the risk of injury related to repetitive motion, and manually lifting and loading/unloading patients into and out of emergency vehicles. This intervention will improve the process of patient handling and lifting. The Beverly-Waterford Township rescue squad provides emergency medical services to portions of Washington, Morgan, and Noble Counties.

### **Gerber Farm Division (Wayne County) Agriculture**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase one chick/shell separator, one shell vac, two hatcher tray transfer conveyors and one chick transfer conveyor to reduce the risk of injury to back, shoulders, neck and hands due to contusions, hands intensive work, lifting, pushing, pulling and repetitive motion. This intervention will reduce the risks associated with incorrect ergonomic postures and repetitive motions, and reduce the manual handling of chicks, shells and shell debris. Gerber Farm Division's Orville location is a chick hatchery processing operation providing raw materials for the chicken processing plant.

### **Riverview Industrial Wood Products Inc. (Wayne County) Manufacturing**

BWC approved \$40,000 to purchase one automated nailing system to reduce the risk of injury to back, neck, hands and arms due to cuts, contusions, lifting, hand intensive work and repetitive motion. This intervention will reduce the manual nailing and handling of pallets during the production process.

Riverview Industrial Wood Products manufactures wood pallets, skids and crates.

### **Tarpstop LLC. (Wood County) Manufacturing**

BWC approved \$36,015 to purchase four scissor lifts to reduce the risk of injury or strain to the upper and lower extremities related to repetitive motion, awkward postures and fall from heights. This intervention will improve the installation process. Tarpstop manufactures truck tarpaulins and tarp systems for flatbed trailers, dump trucks and trailers. Tarpstop's primary focus is installing and servicing the tarp systems that they manufacture.
