

Public Forum Registration

Thank you for your interest in participating in the public forum on enhancing BWC's claims management system by shifting the model from disability management to disability prevention issues. The BWC Board of Directors will host the forum from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. on Wednesday, April 29, in the auditorium on the second floor of the William Green Building, at 30 W. Spring St., in downtown Columbus.

Participants can provide their insights into enhancing BWC's claims-management system. The discussion will center on shifting the model from disability management to disability prevention. Goals for discussion include:

- Determining efficient methods for identifying workers at risk for long-term disability;
- Identifying appropriate incentives for the delivery of occupational health best practice care sufficient to prevent disability;
- Identifying opportunities for the synthesis of claims-management and medical-management processes to improve outcomes;
- Providing for measurement of the disability prevention achieved to allow for a continuous improvement process.

The Board asks that presentations be kept to a maximum of 3-5 minutes. Presentations will be timed. The session is videotaped and all information is subject to public records requests.
