

# » Industry-Specific Safety Program detailed minimum requirements

These are minimum requirements. Feel free to participate in more activities if it makes sense to do so.

If your company's reported payroll is:

- Less than \$100,000, you must complete at least one loss-prevention activity credit;
- Between \$100,000 and \$300,000, you must complete at least two loss-prevention activity credits;
- Greater than \$300,000, you must complete at least three loss-prevention activity credits.

Loss-prevention activity	Action to complete a loss-prevention activity credit
<p><b>Consulting</b></p> <p>Any of the listed activities in this section can be completed once per program year for credit.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">Consulting services page</a></li> </ul>	<p>Employers can take advantage of the following types of on-site BWC consulting services, and earn one activity credit for each unique type of service they use.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Company-specific safety training</li> <li>• Customer safety team development</li> <li>• Ergonomics assessment</li> <li>• Industrial hygiene assessment</li> <li>• Safety hazard assessment for construction</li> <li>• Safety hazard assessment for general industry</li> <li>• Safety management process evaluation</li> <li>• Accident/claim/injury and near-miss analysis</li> <li>• Safety program/process development</li> </ul> <p>The employer must complete a post-service survey related to each on-site service used to earn the activity credit.</p>
<p><b>Industry-specific training</b></p> <p>Only one activity credit will be awarded for the same class title, no matter how many employees take that class in a particular year.</p> <p>Only classes offered by BWC's Division of Safety &amp; Hygiene will count toward an activity credit.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">Training center page</a></li> <li>• <a href="#">Training locations and class schedule</a></li> <li>• <a href="#">Course descriptions</a></li> <li>• <a href="#">Class registration</a></li> </ul>	<p>The criterion for earning an activity credit in the industry-specific training category is based on the size of your annual payroll. If your annual payroll is:</p> <p><b>\$100,000 or less</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Total of three hours of online* industry-specific training classes; click for <a href="#">online classes</a> or</li> <li>• Any one half-, full- or multiple-day industry-specific class</li> </ul> <p><b>Between \$100,000 and \$300,000</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Any one half-, full- or multiple-day industry-specific class</li> </ul> <p><b>Greater than \$300,000</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Any two half-day, or one full- or multiple-day industry-specific class</li> </ul>
<p><b>Safety Congress</b></p> <p>A maximum of one activity credit can be achieved in this category</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">Safety Congress page</a></li> </ul>	<p>Attend at least</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Three sessions (topic-specific or general); or any one-half day or full-day workshop.</li> </ul>

\* Online classes are not available for Industry-Specific Safety Program credit for payroll levels above \$100,000.
