Thank you for your interest in participating in the Division of Safety and Hygiene (DSH) public forum. The BWC Board of Directors will host the forum from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. on Friday, October 30, in the auditorium on the second floor of the William Green Building, at 30 W. Spring St., in downtown Columbus.

The topic of discussion will be the services and future direction of DSH. Participants are encouraged to address issues related to DSH, including:

- Safety intervention grants
- Safety education and training services
- Ohio Safety Congress & Expo
- On-site and field consultation services
- The OSHA On-Site Program and the Public Employer Risk Reduction Program (PERRP) services
- Increasing the reach of Safety Councils
- Collaboration with similar agencies focused on occupational safety (i.e. Occupational Safety and Health Administration)
- Future direction (i.e. research activities, introduction of new programs)
- Marketing safety and hygiene services
- Collaboration with other state agencies and institutions of higher education (i.e. Ohio Department of Transportation, Ohio Department of Development, Ohio State University)
- Library services

The Board asks that presentations be kept to a maximum of 3-5 minutes. Presentations will be timed. The session is videotaped and all information is subject to public records requests.
