Top 10 mistakes made when implementing a transitional work program

- 10. There is no time limit on the program.
- 9. Employer asks the physician to "OK" a temporary work assignment.
- 8. The only description of the job duties comes from the injured worker.
- 7. Employer does not have the well-being of the injured worker in mind.
- 6. There is no clear distinction between transitional work and a job search.
- 5. The temporary work assignment is not clear to the injured worker.
- 4. The temporary work assignment is not progressive.
- 3. The committee is not flexible in meeting times.
- 2. The employer did not use common sense.
- 1. The employer did not involve the labor unions.
