Weapons of mass destruction/terrorism awareness and interagency response management

This session is a basic weapons of mass destruction (WMD) and terrorism awareness presentation. The session will present case studies and examples regarding interagency response and management of a WMD incident involving release of chemical, biological, radiological and nuclear (CBRN) materials. The session focuses on the interagency threat assessment process and development of courses of action and investigation. Attendees will learn to identify a potential WMD/CBRN incident/scene; define different scenarios that apply to individual agencies; and list points of contact in dealing with a WMD/terrorism incident.
