Overview

General Rehabilitation provides individualized rehabilitation services to any person with decreased function resulting from an injury or illness. The goal of this program is to maximize the client's physical functioning and efficiently return him/her to gainful employment or activities of daily living. Education, self-management, exercise and therapy are integral components of all General Rehabilitation services.

Service Options (Can be provided individually or in combination)

- Physical therapy
- Work conditioning
- Exercise physiology
- Occupational therapy
- Psychological counseling
- Occupational fitness services
- Functional capacity evaluations
- Back dynamic stabilization classes
- Nutritional consultation and weight control
- Aquatic program: individual and group sessions
- Educational classes on back and upper limb injury prevention

Who to refer?

- Clients who are medically stable but have decreased activity tolerance and strength due to an injury or musculoskeletal condition.
- Clients who are working or anticipate a quick return to work with modified duty.
