OCCUPATIONAL REHABILITATION PROGRAM

Overview

The Occupational Rehabilitation Program at the BWC Rehab Center is an aggressive progression of work simulation, physical reconditioning and other therapeutic treatment modalities. This program increases the client's physical capacity and work tolerance for a safe and successful return to work.

This goal-oriented program utilizes an interdisciplinary team including occupational and physical therapists, an exercise physiologist, a psychologist, work simulation technicians, and a program facilitator. Goals and objectives are set and evaluated on a weekly basis with referral sources and treating physicians informed of the client's progress.

Although the Occupational Rehabilitation program can address some pain and psychological issues, this should not be the primary need or focus of the program.
