



#171 How does CSA2010 impact cargo securement? – Basic

All commercial motor vehicles are subject to the cargo securement rules. There are no exceptions for dry vans, motor coaches, dump trucks, straight trucks, or pickups. In fact, any type of vehicle that is considered a commercial motor vehicle, under either state or federal rules, is subject to the cargo securement rules. Because of the importance and depth of the Cargo Securement BASIC, the driver of any type of commercial motor vehicle should take an active role in the loading of the vehicle to make sure the load complies with all safety regulations before setting out on the roadways. You will be able to list two critical items required to properly secure a load; define the working load limit of graded chain; and describe common cargo violations.
