



#511 Is your load ready for the road? Part 1, panel discussion – Intermediate

Typical construction work requires that heavy equipment and materials be moved on and off the work site. In order to safely transport these loads which are often large, heavy and irregularly shaped, operators must be aware of and follow the federal regulations governing load and cargo securement. This session is designed to provide an introductory understanding of the loading and securement regulations for materials and equipment, which must move on public highways and thoroughfares. You will be able to identify the types of materials and equipment governed by federal regulations on load and cargo securement; and explain key considerations that ensure cargo is transported safely.
