



#323 Are you subject to a commercial vehicle inspection? – Basic

This lecture will describe the new Ohio regulations pertaining to roadside requirements of commercial motor vehicle (CMV) inspections with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) or combined gross vehicle weight rating (CGVWR) more than 10,000 pounds. Previous only intrastate CMVs more than 26,000 pounds GVWR or CGVWR were subject to the PUCO regulations. You will be able to explain recent changes to regulations for commercial motor vehicles regarding weight and inspections; describe Ohio's roadside requirements for CMV inspections.
