



**#324 Can I park my service vehicle along the roadway? – Basic**

This lecture will describe the new Ohio regulations pertaining to roadside requirements of commercial motor vehicle (CMV) inspections with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) or combined gross vehicle weight rating (CGVWR) more than 10,000 pounds. Previously only intrastate CMVs more than 26,000 pounds GVWR or CGVWR were subject to the PUCO regulations.

You will be able to identify federal and state regulations for closing roadways; explain the hazards of poor signage for lane or road closures; and describe best practices for warning motorists of temporary road closures.
