

VOCATIONAL SERVICES

Overview

Vocational Services provides two distinct service options that can be requested individually or in combination to optimize the client's potential for success in returning to work.

Service Options

- 1. Vocational Evaluation: A comprehensive or modified vocational evaluation to assess the client's current and potential job skills. Evaluation components include:
 - Vocational interest inventories. aptitude tests, academic functioning tests, standardized work samples and transferable skills analysis
- Identification of vocational potential, vocational options and recommendations
- 2. Career Counseling/Job Placement*: Provide both job search preparation and a structured job search program. Program components include:
 - One week of Job Seeking Skills Training (JSST)
 - Vocational exploration
 - Resume development

 - Individual career counseling and job placement (JOBS)
- Employer contact lists and job leads
- Job placement follow-up
- Job search monitoring
- Job application and interview skills Job development
 - Job club
