

Distribution of public employer rebates by county and industry

Under Another Billion Back, a proposal by Governor John Kasich and Administrator/CEO Steve Buehrer, the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC) would return an estimated \$126 million to 3,800 public employer taxing districts. The plan would return \$1 billion to Ohio private employers and local governments, as well as build on last year's \$15 million investment in safety intervention grants and create several initiatives to enhance the safety, health and wellness of Ohio's workforce. The tables below detail the distribution of the \$126 million to public employer taxing districts. The first table shows the estimated total amount being distributed to each county. The second table shows the amount being distributed to each industry included in the definition of a public employer taxing district. The final table shows a county-by-county breakdown by these industries. Please note the amounts are estimates.

The BWC Board of Directors will vote on the plan in September. If approved, BWC expects to begin sending checks to eliqible employers in October.
