Avoid hits with these BWC tips

Getting hit by an object can be a particular concern in the manufacturing industry where workers encounter a number of materials that can cause serious injuries or even death. Staying vigilant and following safety procedures are the keys to avoiding collisions.

BWC has several recommendations for reducing the risk of getting struck by objects. These include:

- Properly guarding machines and tools;
- Using screens or partitions to reduce flying debris and particles;
- Avoiding the use of mechanically powered vehicles in the proximity of workers:
- Clearly marking vehicle routes and pedestrian walkways.
