Other products can be absorbed through skin or accidentally inhaled, potentially leading to lung diseases and cancer.

Monitoring levels of dust and fumes is difficult without the proper tools and knowledge. Fortunately, BWC offers resources and information to protect your employees from the dangers of dust and fumes.

BWC recommends taking the following steps to make your work site safer:

- Assessing air contaminants and noise levels to determine exposures;
- Enclosing dust-producing equipment;
- Using rock dusting or wetting to reduce dust;
- Deploying local exhaust ventilation to capture air contaminants at the source.
